October is here and cool temps will not be far behind. If the forecasted low is anywhere close to 40 you can more than likely expect to have a frost delay that morning. It is important for everyone to note that if we have a morning that we have frost the course and practice facility will not be open until it melts off. Walking on a grass plant, especially shortly mown areas, will cause that plant to immediately go dormant and turn brown. We will do our best to keep early morning play informed of frost delays. However, it's better to be safe than sorry! If you feel like there is frost present, please stay off the course and practice facility until the temperature rises to such a degree that the frost melts off. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Fall Maintenance

Joe and his staff have begun what we refer to as fall projects. These projects include tile work, irrigation repair, tree removal, green and tee aerification, etc. These projects can occur on any day of the week weather depending. As most of you are aware fall aerification typically occurs the day after Labor Day so we've been treated to multiple weeks of fantastic putting surfaces in the month of September where other courses are still healing. There is a short window of opportunity to complete these projects, so your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. If not playing the course in order **YOU WILL HAVE TO ALLOW OUR MAINTENANCE STAFF TIME TO COMPLETE THEIR WORK.** What this equates to is skipping the hole that the maintenance is occurring on such as mowing, spraying, etc.

How Close is too Close?

The above examples show carts that are obviously too close to the green. At what point do I need to return to the cart path has always been an opened ended question. **At our club we would like to see carts return to the path once your reach 30 yards from the green.** Ideally, we would like to see carts utilizing the cart paths when traveling to and from shots which in return gives all golfers better playing conditions. When a path is not the most convenient, we ask that you utilize the rough. Exiting and approaching a cart path in random areas will also leave the turf in better condition. Repeated cart traffic will result in poor turf conditions. Please assist us in keeping your course in great shape by following these simple steps.
