GHIN Handicap posting season ending.

The last day to post scores made on golf courses within the IGA's region is Sunday, November 14th. When a golfer is wondering whether a score can be posted because of the season, here's the key question to ask, "Is the course I played currently observing their active season?" If the answer is yes, the score should be posted. If an IGA member travels to Arizona in December and plays golf, those scores should be posted because Arizona observes an active season year-round.

Why the Need for Active and Inactive Seasons?

The USGA Course Rating[™] and Slope Rating[™] represent the difficulty of a golf course during mid-season playing conditions. Although the club and weather may permit play during the late fall and winter months, the varying conditions during the off-season months can alter the playability of the golf course (e.g., faster/slower fairways and greens, loss of foliage and rough height fluctuation). Ratings issued to the club reflect the conditions of the course during the prime playing season. Posting scores made during the inactive season period for handicap purposes can affect a player's Handicap Index[™] and must not be posted. To provide consistency in posting scores throughout a region, all clubs within a certain area must abide by the active/inactive seasons and handicap revision schedule established by the authorized golf association.

Frost & Frozen Greens

If frost is present anywhere on the golf course, we'd like to remind everyone that you may **NOT TEE OFF OR USE ANY OF THE PRACTICE FACILITIES**. We will encounter numerous mornings where the greens will freeze over night and not thaw out until early afternoon. When the greens are frozen you may **NOT TEE OFF OR USE ANY OF THE PRACTICE FACILITIES**. If the clubhouse is not be open, please look for signage of the 1st tee. If the clubhouse is not open and there isn't signage on the first tee and you're unsure, please text Superintendent Joe Burke at 515 - 249 - 8543. There are a few times we assume there won't be any play and low and behold someone will.

Clubhouse - Mulligans Hours
