

# How close is too close?

Below is a perfect example of what **NOT** to do.



Over the course of the last few weeks, I have had an excessive number of complaints regarding poor golf cart etiquette. The following is what is expected of every member and guest at your club.

- 1. Return to the cart path once you're 30 yards from the green.
- 2. Leave your golf cart on the cart path when you are at a tee box.
- 3. Observe the 90 degree rule at all times travel to and from shots on the continuous cart paths.
- 4. Par 3's Remain on the path for the entire hole on #4, #16 and #18. On #7 and #9 you may leave the path for shots short of the creek.

If you, or a guest, have a medical condition that doesn't allow you to be able to follow the above rules please contact us and we will be you a handicap flag to fly on your cart. This way others can identify you as one who has permission to not follow these requirements.

#### **Dress Code Policy for Members & Guests**

In the last month we have observed a few of our members and guests not following our dress code policy. The below policy has been in place of over four years now, so we are expecting everyone to be observant of the policy put in place by your Board of Directors.

Golf Course Dress Code = At Indianola Country Club we want all of our members and guests to have an enjoyable experience during their round of golf. The membership at Indianola Country Club prides themselves on having a private club experience with affordable prices. The goal at our club is to allow casual dress with the understanding that we are a private facility. Muscle shirts, tank tops, un-hemmed cut offs and tee shirts with graphics are not allowed. A solid-colored tee shirt without graphics and in good condition is allowed. However, outerwear pieces, such as sweatshirts, will be allowed with graphics if the graphics are not inappropriate. A collared golf shirt and golf related layering piece is our preferred choice. female members and guests are allowed to wear sleeveless golf shirts designed for the golf course. Female golfers must wear a top and bottom that doesn't reveal too much. Again, we want our dress code to be relaxed but not to the point that others find it distracting, disturbing or inappropriate. Golf Shoes or golf sandals with soft spikes or athletic shoes must be always worn while playing. Members and guests are not allowed to play barefooted or with footwear that could damage the grass plant. It is every member's responsibility to make sure their guests are aware of our dress code policy on the golf course.

**Clubhouse Dress Code** = At Indianola Country Club we want all of our members and guests to have an enjoyable and relaxed experience. Muscle shirts, tank tops, unhemmed cut offs, dirty and or poor conditioned clothing, any piece of apparel with inappropriate graphics or suggestive sayings are not allowed. Our goal is to give you every opportunity to enjoy your clubhouse experience in a casual yet neat appearance. It is every member's responsibility to make sure their guests are aware of our dress code policy prior to entering the clubhouse.
