From the Board of Directors

Whether it is your business or personal life, we are all feeling the impact inflation has had on all aspects of our day-to-day life.

The Indianola Country Club is not immune to the inflation pressure on their daily operations. So far in the year 2022, inflation has had an undeniable impact across various aspects of operations. Inflation will continue to drive up the operating expenses of the Club. Year to date, the cost of goods has increased 5.88% while operating expenses have trended up 11.71% over the previous year. Year over year, fuel, which includes both electricity and gasoline, has increased 54%. Some of this increase can be contributed to additional carts being utilized by members. We appreciate and encourage members to start riding together again as this will help stabilize fuel expenses through lower cart usage.

Since 2014, improvements to the Club have totaled \$717,290 through October of 2022. Additionally, the Club has reduced the debt on the "New Nine" expansion by \$448,666 while paying off the loan on the "Driving Range" to the City of Indianola totaling \$70,000. This totals \$1,235,956 in debt reduction, improvements, and equipment for the Club. The improvements and equipment have been paid from dues and capital improvement fees and not financed.

The following are some of the projects and equipment purchased over the past several years:

Remodel of Mulligans Bar Re-paving of parking lot and driveway Men's and Ladies locker room remodel New Yanmar tractor with attachments Replacement of bridge on #7 Cart path resurfacing Irrigation system upgrade along with replacement of irrigation pumps New Patio and cart paths around the clubhouse New Beverage Cart Point of Sale System

Hats off to our staff in managing all the projects completed over the past several years. Their efforts and passion for improvement has allowed Indianola Country Club to enhance the member experience. The board has taken great pride in being able to invest profitable cashflows back into our course and facility. During a time when multiple courses have struggled, Indianola Country Club has been the beneficiary of prudent financial management.

With that said management and the board must remain diligent with the finances of your Club. Inflation currently is hovering around 8%. To keep pace with inflation and to ensure we maintain an acceptable budget, we will be looking at an annual increase in dues of 7-9%. The adjustment will be effective April 2023. The budget will be finalized by the end of the year, however we wanted to be transparent as a board. Most importantly Indianola Country Club is financially positioned to be successful through the ups and downs of the economy.

We appreciate your continued support and questions, and comments are always welcome at the board meeting.


