Our club will be participating in PGA Junior League again in 2023. PGA Junior League is a way to introduce junior golfers to a team aspect of golf. We, the PGA, want to introduce a team aspect of the game to junior golfers. There are plenty of events for junior golfers competing as individuals who like and want stroke play events. However, every child enjoys the team aspect of sports. This program allows us to introduce competition to our junior membership in a fun and non-stressful environment. We will be part of the Des Moines area league and compete against team in the metro area. When a team has a competition/game the matches will consist of a total of 9 holes. The nine holes will consist of three three hole tournaments for a total of 3 points per nine holes. When a competition/game is held we will need a minimum of eight players as there will be four nine hole matches for a total of 12 points. Everyone who is part of PGA Junior League may travel so more than eight participating is great! When this occurs, we will sub in a player after a 3 hole match and every junior is guaranteed 6 holes. The format for PJL is a 2 - person best shot so being an advanced player is not a requirement. For more information, please visit the links below.

Driving Range Reminder

I've been asked to remind everyone of a few key points to using the driving range.

1. You are not allowed to hit shots to the putting green that leave ball marks. You're more than welcome to chip and putt on the practice green but pitching is not allowed.

- 2. Please leave your golf cart parked on the cart path. Carts are not allowed to be driven across or on the teeing ground.
- 3. Please do your best to NOT hit shots that end up in homeowner's yards. We've worked hard to clear out the area on the left so please aim far enough left so that your shot stay on our range.
- 4. As many of you have found out, or have heard, we are extremely low on range tokens. In 11 years we've ordered 7000 tokens and last week we were down to none in the clubhouse and only 34 in the range token box. We kindly ask that you look through your golf bag, golf cart, etc. for tokens that you have picked up and not used. We have additional tokens ordered, but like a lot of things are on backorder.
- 5. Members and guests must hit from the designated area. If the designated area is too far forward that your driver goes through the range you may move back **so long as there aren't others on the range as we'd like to keep everyone safe.**



Beverage Cart to soon accept credit and debit cards!

We are currently working with our credit card processing company to obtain a mobile card reader that we can use on the beverage cart. Our goal is to make it more convenient for the member and guest as well as take out the work of keeping track of tabs for our beverage cart employees. Please note the card reader is NOT going to be able to accept gift cards as the gift cards run off a completely different system configured with the inside Point of Sale. We kindly ask that you do not ask our employees to run a tab inside for beverage cart purchases for the sake of using a gift card when you're done. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Golf Course Played East – West/Reversed on Tuesday

The golf course will be played East – West every Tuesday now through mid-September. There are two key factors that go into this decision.

- 1. The Men's League begins at approximately 4:00 p.m. and the league needs to be able to utilize two starting holes to allow all 72 players the opportunity to play matches. Due to our layout the 10th hole is not able to be utilized as a starting hole based on it's location and we can't see if that hole is even available based on not being able to see if anyone is on the 9th hole.
- 2. This gives our maintenance staff one day a week to be able to do maintenance on the West Nine without having to juggle play for the first few hours of each morning.

We have specific scorecards for this layout so please feel free to pick those up prior to teeing off. Please note due to #2 being used as the 1st tee for the West Nine we stop taking tee times on Tuesday's at 2:00 p.m. All play after that tee time is first come first served. Anyone who had a tee time prior to 2:00 p.m. has the right of way when going from #18 to #2. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE COURSE IS <u>NOT</u> CLOSED DURING MEN'S LEAGUE. The first tees will be busy between 4:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.
