Golf Course Played East – West/Reversed on Tuesday

The golf course will be played East – West every Tuesday now through mid-September. There are two key factors that go into this decision.

- 1. The Men's League begins at approximately 4:00 p.m. and the league needs to be able to utilize two starting holes to allow all 72 players the opportunity to play matches. Due to our layout the 10th hole is not able to be utilized as a starting hole based on it's location and we can't see if that hole is even available based on not being able to see if anyone is on the 9th hole.
- 2. This gives our maintenance staff one day a week to be able to do maintenance on the West Nine without having to juggle play for the first few hours of each morning.

We have specific scorecards for this layout so please feel free to pick those up prior to teeing off. Please note due to #2 being used as the 1st tee for the West Nine we stop taking tee times on Tuesday's at 2:00 p.m. All play after that tee time is first come first served. Anyone who had a tee time prior to 2:00 p.m. has the right of way when going from #18 to #2. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE COURSE IS NOT CLOSED DURING MEN'S LEAGUE. The first tees will be busy between 4:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.

It's that time of year that we like to remind everyone of a few simple club policies here at the club.

Golf Carts

Carts should travel to and from shots on the continuous cart paths as much as possible. Carts should return to the cart path once you're 30 yards away from the green. Carts should remain on the cart path at all tee boxes.

Repeated cart traffic will lead to poorer turf conditions.

Our maintenance staff appreciates your support and cooperation.

Golf Course Dress code

We've had a few comments as of late of dress code so please note the dress code for the golf course below.

Muscle shirts, tank tops, un-hemmed cut off shorts and tee shirts with graphics are not allowed. A solid-colored tee shirt without graphics and in good condition is allowed. However, outerwear pieces, such as sweatshirts, will be allowed with graphics if the graphics are not inappropriate. A collared golf shirt and golf related layering piece is our preferred choice. Our female members and guests can wear sleeveless golf shirts designed for the golf course. Female golfers must wear a top and bottom that does not reveal too much. Again, we want our dress code to be relaxed but

not to the point that others find it distracting, disturbing or inappropriate. Golf Shoes or golf sandals with soft spikes or athletic shoes must always be worn while playing. **Members and guests are not allowed to play barefooted** or with footwear that could damage the grass plant.

Our membership continues to grow and joining a new club can be confusing at times so please reach out if you have any questions.
